The Clinical Establishments (Registration & Regulation) Act, 2010.

<u>Introduction:</u> The Clinical Establishments (Registration & Regulation) Act, 2010 has been enacted by the Central Government to provide for registration and regulation of all clinical establishments in the country with a view to prescribe the minimum standards of facilities and services provided by them. Goals:

a). Toprovide minimum acceptable quality of services to the community.

b). Tocreate awareness among the community regarding registered medical practitioners and establishments so as to phase out quacks from the country.
