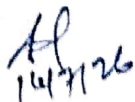

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Authorized Dealers/Distributors/Stockist or agents should furnish Photo copy of their Dealership/Distributorship/Stockist or Agencies Certificate duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary and should produce Original Certificate at the time of opening the tender, if demanded.
2. All pages of the tender should be duly numbered and arranged in accordance with the prescribed terms and conditions. Page index indicating all the documents attached alongwith their page no. should be maintained on the first page of the tender document.
3. Quotation of rates with name of manufacturer and brandname alongwith other necessary details should be submitted as per the *prescribed format only* which can be obtained from the office of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl on working days.
4. The cover of the tender should be superscribed as '**Open Tender for Supply of Medicines under NHM, Mizoram**' addressed to the Mission Director, National Health Mission, Dinthar, Aizawl clearly indicating full postal address of the tenderer.
5. Non-tribal tenderer should affix a Non- Judicial Court Fee Stamp worth at least Rs.7.50/- and should furnish attested copy of GST registration certificate by the concerned authority, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer.
6. The tribal tenderer should furnish copy of Scheduled Tribe Certificate and GST Registration Certificate issued by the competent authority duly attested by a Gazetted Officer. Original copies should be produced at the time of opening, if demanded.



7. Tenders should be accompanied with the Earnest Money Deposit of 2% of the total value of the quoted items in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt/ Banker's Cheque/ Bank Guarantee in original, from any commercial banks having validity for atleast 45 days, duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
8. Manufacturers submitting their tenders directly should attach photocopies of their Manufacturing Licence, Drugs Licence, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licences required for such manufacturing, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the tenders/quotations, if demanded.
9. The supplier must complete the delivery of the ordered items strictly within the delivery period stipulated by the State Health Society. In case of failure to supply within the specified time:
 - i) A penalty may be imposed as deemed appropriate by the Society.
 - ii) The Society reserves the right to cancel the supply order in part or in full, if supply cannot be made without any intimation. The Society shall also have the right to procure the items from alternative sources from the fund sanctioned against such items and the said purchase would not entail any legal implication on the part of the Society.
10. Tenderers shall clearly mention – 'Rates are quoted inclusive of GST and all other taxes, duties and applicable charges' in the quotation. Tenderers should quote their rates in terms of *Indian Rupees*. Tenderers shall quote 'NIL' for items not quoted, which shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered. If there are more than one brand, the separate rates for such brands with necessary details should be mentioned.
11. Tenderers should clearly mention - F.O.R. destination is '**Central Medical Store, Zemabawk / All health facilities within Mizoram**' in the quotation. Transportation/shipping or any additional charge will be borne by the successful bidder.
12. At the time of supply, the supplied item should have at least one year (12months) shelf-life before its expiry date from manufacture and expiry date must be indicated on the body of the items supplied by the suppliers. Besides, the supplier shall mandatorily submit a Certificate of Analysis (CoA) for each batch of medicines supplied. The CoA must be issued either by Govt. Approved Testing Laboratory or the In-House Quality Control Laboratory of the manufacturer.
13. No price escalation will be permissible during the agreement period and rates of items over and above approved rates will not be accepted. Quoted rates should not exceed the printed MRP of the quoted items.
14. All tenders/quotations shall be accompanied by attested copy of valid General Drugs Licence. Original document may be produced for verification at the time of tender opening.
15. The tenderer should submit attested/notarized copy of up-to-date ISO/GMP Certificate alongwith tender documents.
16. The supplied items should conform to the quality standards as prescribed for each item. In case of any item found to be 'not of standard quality', the firm shall be considered for blacklisting and further forfeiture of security deposit. The supplier shall retrieve all batches of the product as it shall be deemed to be rejected goods and replace the same at their own cost. The Society will be at the liberty to arrange alternative procurement from any other source.

17. Soft copy of tender document shall be enclosed alongwith other documents.
18. All pages of the tender papers should be printed, signed, stamped and dated; hand written quotations shall not be entertained. Any page or pages not signed, stamped and dated will be marked violated clause at the time of opening of tender.
19. *Samples for all items* shall be submitted in a separate box/packet marked as SAMPLE. Each sample is to be labeled clearly with name of the firm and sl.no of the item in the prescribed form which may be reclaimed after completion of the tender process.
20. A successful tenderer has to sign the Deeds of Agreement within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of communication of acceptance of his/her quoted rate(s) failing which the tender will become invalid.
21. If any tenderer violates or fails to fulfill any one of the clauses, his or her tender are liable to be rejected at the time of opening the tender by the *Technical Committee and Purchase Board, MSHS*.
22. Once the rate is accepted and communicated to the successful firm, the same will remain valid during the supply period of the agreement with the approved supplier and no price escalation will be permissible during the valid period, which is normally for a period of 12 months and is extendable, if mutually agreed upon by both the parties i.e. Mizoram State Health Society and concerned approved supplier, subject to the recommendation of the Purchase Committee, Mizoram State Health Society, as the case may be.
23. A successful tenderer whose tender has been accepted shall furnish Security Deposit of 5% (five percent) of the value of the materials required to be supplied, at the time of execution of the agreement, in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft/ Fixed Deposit Receipt/ Bank Guarantee in original, from any commercial banks duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
24. The quantity specified may be increased/decreased upto 20% without any change in the unit price or other terms & conditions of the bid/bidding documents.
25. The undersigned shall not be bound to accept the lowest rate and reserves the right to accept any tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
26. In case the lowest approved bidder is not in the position to supply the full quantity required, the remaining quantity, as far as possible, may be ordered from the next higher responsive bidder at the rates offered by the lowest responsive bidder.
27. Late/delayed tenders will not be entertained. Documents other than those stated in the above clauses should not be attached. Any other/further clarifications in connection with submission of the tender may be made to the office of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl during office hours on all working days.
28. In case of any legal disputes/litigations arising out of this Tender Notice or its terms, the Courts of Law at Aizawl only shall have jurisdiction to adjudicate the same.

29. All payments will be made only after the items are received in full and in good condition duly approved/accepted by the *Vigilance Committee*, H & FW Dept./Competent Authority. Part payment will not be entertained.
30. Any attempt for negotiation/campaign, direct or indirect, on the part of a tenderer with the authority to whom he has submitted the Tender or the authority who is competent finally to accept, shall render such Tender liable to be excluded from consideration, if proved.

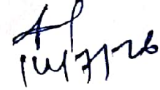
